The stunning Italian town of Ravello stands at the top of the world or that is how it feels. Perched high on the cliffs above Amalfi, the view to the Mediterranean below is to die for, that's if the hairpin bends don't kill you first! Rocky escarpments, lemon orchards and azure sea are just some of the characteristics that make Ravello one of the jewels in the crown of the Amalfi coast line.

Recover from your drive along the Amalfi Corniche – the wiggling and precipitous coast road. (The views are spectacular and if your taxi or bus driver is Italian be warned it could feel like a close shave with death!) then wander through the winding alleys, busy streets, enjoy a glass of wine in the town's main square and soak up the atmosphere

Ravello's beauty has inspired visitors for generations. Famous writers and artists of the 18th and 19th centuries, who chose to make it their key destinations on their Grand Tour, favoured the town. The German composer Wagner used the view as inspiration for his opera Parsifal, while writers DH Lawrence, Truman Capote and Tennessee Williams fell in love with the town.

With town houses built high on mountain sides, cascading down to the sea, Ravello is renown for its spectacular vistas and its gardens. Each year, the Ravello Concert Society organises a season of chamber music concerts (March-November), most of which are held against a backdrop of sky and sea in the panoramic gardens of Wagner's inspiration for Parsifal, the Villa Rufolo. Take a stroll through Ravello's two famous gardens, Villa Cimbrone and Villa Rufolo. Both are open to the public, allowing visitors to wander through the tropical plants and marvel at the incomparable views of the coastline. Ravello also has an impressive cathedral, the venerable Duomo, dedicated to San Pantaleone whose blood is a treasured relic.

- Ticket for the Sunrise Concert at the Belvedere di Villa Rufolo on 11 August 2012; advance booking fee and hotel delivery included.

The hotel is located in a wonderful position in the historical centre of Ravello. The hotel has a breathtaking view over the sea. The Villa Rufolo, where the Sunrise Concert takes place, is walking distance from the hotel (3 minutes away).
